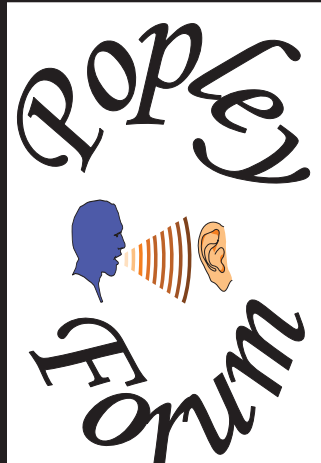

Over the last few weeks quite a few of the Popley young people have been working outside the centre. Under the "Art in the Community Project" it is a follow up on the landscaping of the old centre ground. After being successful in obtaining grants from three sources, Crime prevention, Youth 2000 and BDBC

parks dept. Several workshops have taken place. The age range to be catered for was 12-18 yrs, but we also had a lot of very young budding artists and we did not like to turn anyone away from enjoying art in whatever form. Charlie Carter, the artist commissioned for the project, has had his work cut out devising various different methods of work and designs so all ages could participate, and arrive at the end design which will be the centre piece of the landscaped garden. FIRE Risk from Rubbish

If you live in a flat or maisonette you should take care not to leave rubbish lying around in porches or on staircases. Unfortunately rubbish is an easy target for arsonists.

Some flats in Melrose Walk were gutted by fire last year because rubbish left out overnight by residents was set alight. Since then Oakfern Housing, which owns the blocks of flats in Melrose Walk, has installed smoke and heat detectors and lined the porches to all the blocks with fire resistant board. This work stopped a potentially serious fire at another block in January.
